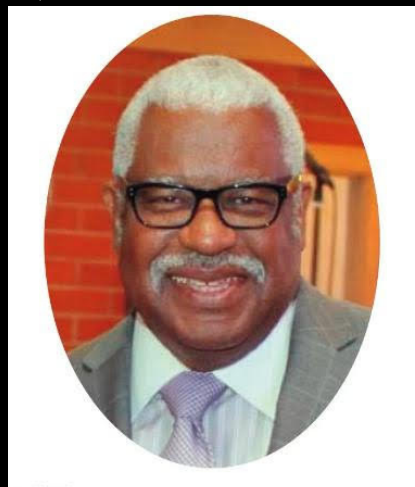


ONE OF GOD'S SOLDIERS HAS BEEN CALLED HOME

OUR MISSION

THE SHARP PROJECT, FUNDED THROUGH THE CA ARTS COUNCIL, ALLOWS US TO REVITALIZE AND RE-IMAGINE THE SUGAR HILL ARTS DISTRICT NOT ONLY AS A HISTORIC PRESERVATION SITE AND LANDMARK DESTINATION OF AFRICAN-AMERICAN HISTORY, ARTS, ACTIVISM, CIVIC ENGAGEMENT, LEADERSHIP, AND STRATEGIC VISION – BUT ALSO AS A SITE OF COMMUNITY BUILDING AND URBAN RENEWAL.
